_Celebrating a Milestone Year! ____ Great Marques 2022 Report

Historic, Iconic, Monumental, Great Marques 2022 in the magnificent gardens of Old Westbury, was an event like no other. For 2021 Sean Ayrai, our intrepid Section Director showed our group an article in "Road and Track Magazine" highlighting the Cannonball round-trip record-breaking feat of Chris Clemens & and Mark Spence - (<u>https://www.roadandtrack.com/news/a37080863/back-toback-cannonball/</u>) and made contact.



Chris (see Chris's Impression below) was honored last year by our Section and showed off his 1999 **R129 SL500**. That started a beautiful friendship and became the lynch pin for Great Marques 2022. Along with the New York – Long Island Section and our leader, President, Oliver Seligman, we reached out to Long Island friends, BMW and Ferrari to host a Cannonball Icon Day reunion (the last such reunion was in 2020 with 75 participants and in 2022 over 300) and built our show around them. Mercedes Benz has long been

a major participant in Cannonball runs and has had several record holders. It's not a surprise to most Mercedes Benz followers that our cars are built like no other and excel at outrunning most automobiles in the marketplace. Just a quick glance at racing history will tell you that. The Great Marques show has grown over the years and always features something special. We always try to add a new element to our shows like honoring the 50 years of 107's for 2021 and our Directors are chosen to reflect where the section is going. This year besides a heavier Social Media push - we distributed flyers about the show to MB dealerships, higher end repair facilities, other weekend car shows to spread the word. A larger push was made to involve the local media and we followed up with ads in local papers

Our shows are held at Old Westbury Gardens, a jewel of the Gold Coast mansions that dotted Long Island during the late 18 and early 19 centuries. One of our Directors, Robert Hussey sits on their board which facilitates our use of the property. It's the largest tract of undeveloped land in Nassau County which is just a few miles East of New York City. Only a few of these historic homes remain.

Our team of Directors, VP, Lou Palumbo, of Gullwing Motors in Mineola stores supplies for the Great Marques Day as well as host our meetings or offers Tech Sessions on the care of our MB's. Director, Allen Lipp oversaw training of new Concours judges and was Chief Judge for Great Marques. Our wives and girlfriends filled in the team to staff the special tents on the field. Gullwing Motors always host breakfast and coffee for the early arrivers and directors on site. It all seems so seamless but, the day resembles a bee's nest. Most of all we want our members to have a FUN experience and we make sure all members are welcome. Our membership always seems to grow during these efforts.

We always reach out to our Sponsors who – without their support – the show would not go on. Our local host Mercedes Benz Dealer is Rallye Motors in nearby Roslyn (https://www.rallyemotors.com/) they have been our supporter for years. Plycar (https://plycargroup.com/) returned and helped with shipping some of the Cannonball cars to Old Westbury. The McGovern Auto Group was very generous for 2022 (https://www.mcgovernauto.com/). Will Branston from Motorcar Classics (https://www.motorcarclassics.com/) is a very dear friend and very generous to the Club.

This year we teamed up with Cannonball, and the newer, C2C group and we began planning our September show last December. We had members from as far away as New Zealand and met regularly on Zoom. All our Board members

use their talents. Sean Ayrai (see Sean's Impression below) is an expert on all things digital, controls his drone for exceptional aerial pictures of the field and captures stills of our guest's Mercedes. He also helps manage the event. Then there is John McAuliffe, our Communications Director that helped all our sections go digital 15 years ago, Lou Palumbo that runs Gullwing Motors, a repair and restoration shop with his son, Steven. Allen Lipp that runs Automobile Professionals, a group that values exceptional autos, Bob Hussey an entrepreneur, Mike Carroll, a lover of all thing's automobile, and our newest Member Yuri Marus. We have experienced people in John Anaischik and his wife Susan that got everyone, organized the correct categories, pre- printed their class envelopes and helped them when they arrived at the show. John also gets the trophies and helps distribute them. Together they also compile the list of winners.

For the first time we utilized more than just the fields of Old Westbury Gardens. On Friday evening we held a fundraiser/reception at the BARN for the Make – A – Wish foundation and we used that as a steppingstone to expand the reach of the club. At that reception we gave an award to Pam Yates, Brock Yates wife, that started the Cannonball Run back in 1971. Chris Clemens was also awarded a plaque. He drove his family's 1999 500SL across and back the USA reached out and got the Ferrari Daytona that Brock Yates drove to be at the show. One of our many guests, Ed Bolian, founder of Vinwiki brought his 600CL which too, broke a record. Ben Wilson, a fellow C2C alumni and I were talking about finally doing something for the 50th anniversary of Cannonball. We initially thought of just having a section of cannonball cars with a Halo area, but this grew to a 3 day event with a cocktail party, panel discussions with the Original Cannonballers, Modern Cannonballers and the event organizers. Film and documentary announcements were made on Saturday and finally the Concours d'Elegance on Sunday which, as I had expected in the past, a wonderfully light hearted and fun event.

The whole weekend was a fun time filled with fellowship from all the groups involved and I am delighted to have been a part of it.

The New York City-Long Island section has always played a leading role in organizing the Great Marques Concours every year and this year they took it to the next level. I contacted Chris Clemens through LinkedIn after reading about his historic record of making it from New York to LA and back to New York in 74:05 hours in his 1999 R129 SL 500 in Road and Track Magazine. Chris agreed to come to the show last year and was placed in the halo area among other noteworthy vehicles.

After a great event, the section stayed in touch with Chris and one day he brought the idea of a Cannonball reunion to be part of the weekend. Fast forward a year later and after many months of planning and logistics, a very special weekend happened on the historic grounds of Old Westbury New York.

The weekend kicked off Friday night with a cocktail party honoring Pam Yates (Wife of the late Brock



Yates who is considered the father of Cannonball, Editor for Car and Driver, and producer of the Cannonball movies) and Chris Clemens awarded by Section President Oliver Seligman and MBCA Section Director and Old Westbury Gardens Board member, Robert Hussey




On Saturday over 300 Cannonballers from the 70s and 80s and modern area record breakers and their cars came together for their reunion. Some of the notable people and cars were the Ferrari Daytona that Brock yates set the original Cannonball record, Ed Bolian's CL55 that set the last pre-pandemic record, and Arne Toman and Doug Tabbut with their E63 and Audi S6 that hold the current coast to coast record of 25:39. Alex Roy was also there who broke the


